CURRICULUM INTENT

KS3 students are introduced to various techniques, materials and processes explored through a diverse range of artists. Students transition to their next school with a preliminary understanding of drawing, print, photography, paint, collage, sculpture and how to research artists/art movements.

SCULPTURE

WE WILL EXPLORE:

Structure, scale, shape, turning 2D drawings to 3D.

Colour Theory, tints, tones and blending.

MEDIA: Acrylic and watercolour paint.

COLLAGE

WE WILL EXPLORE:

Layering, symbolism, and composition.

MEDIA: Collage, montage, and mixed media.

DRAWING

WE WILL EXPLORE:

Mark-making, proportions, tone and perspective.

USING: Pencil, biro, ink, chalk and charcoal.

PRINT

WE WILL EXPLORE:

Light and dark, creating texture and mark-making.

USING: Mono, Lino and relief printing.

PHOTOGRAPHY

WE WILL EXPLORE:

Space, Rule of thirds, Shadows and Highlights.

USING: Digital, Analogue cameras and cyanotypes.
