RESPECT

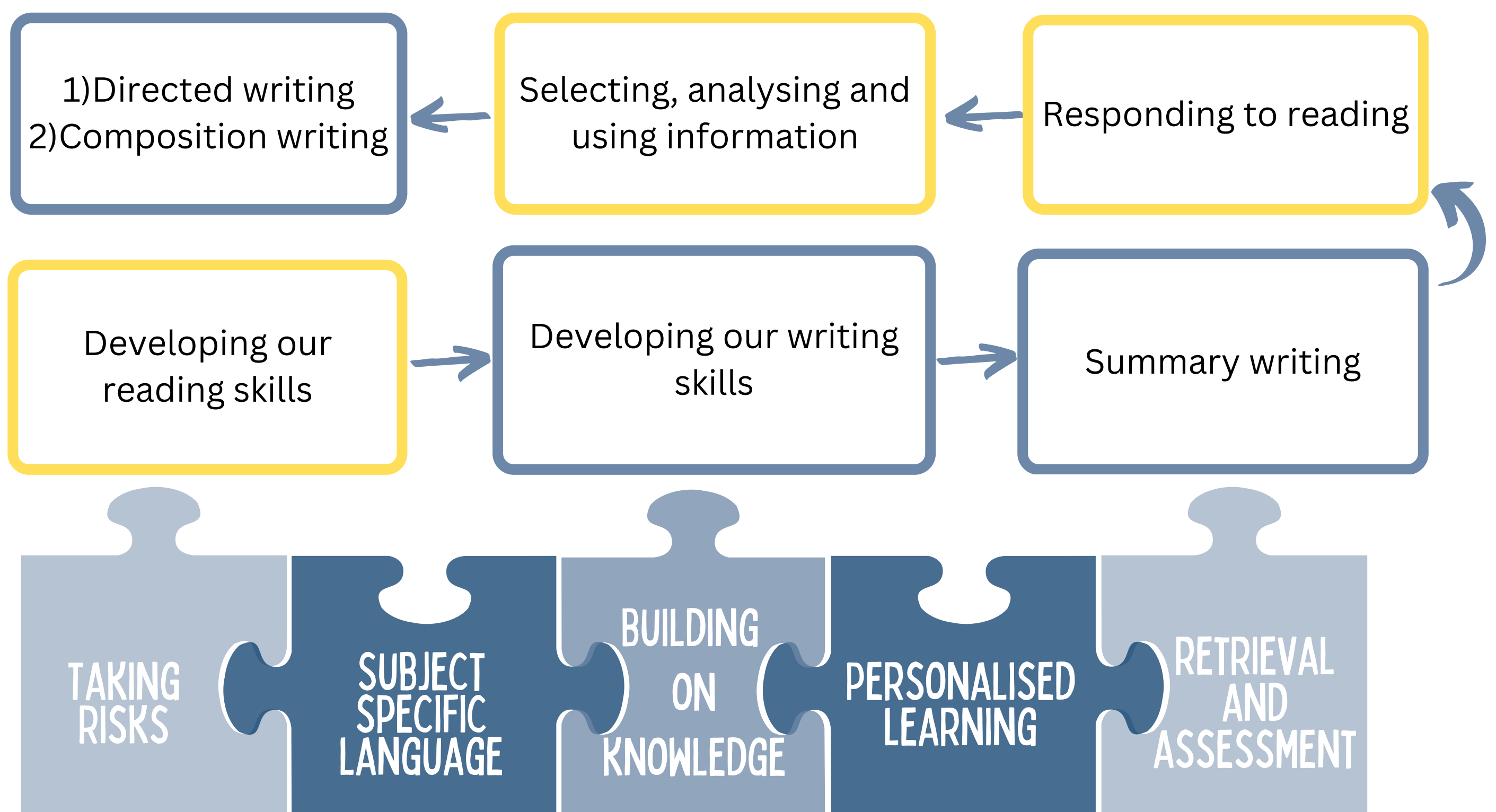
In English we show respect by listening to others and we value the differences in beliefs and opinions.
